Non-stop service between the United States and Cologne, Germany, begins May 10 on Continental Airlines. Among those selected to be on the inaugural flight will be a group from the Indianapolis-Cologne Sister City Committee.

The adventure begins at 11:25 a.m. May 10 when Continental Flight 2154 lifts off from Indianapolis International Airport, and continues on board Continental Flight 110, departing from Newark at 6:45 p.m. for the first non-stop service from the U.S. to Indianapolis' Sister City, Cologne.
